Call for participation Blended Intensive Programme (BIP) Projects Host-Fungus Interactions and Virulence: One health Approach and

Mechanism and Regulation of Cell Death and Autophagy

Deadline for applications: 31/03/2025 12:00 noon

1. PREMISES AND PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Department of Sustainable Development and Ecological Transition offers 3 students the possibility to participate in the Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Program 'Host-Fungus Interactions and Virulence: One health Approach' and 4 students the possibility to participate in the Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Program 'Mechanism and Regulation of Cell Death and Autophagy', both offered by the Universidade do Minho of Braga (Portugal).

Participation in the project entails the acquisition of Erasmus+ student/student status and the recognition of international teaching activities, as per art. 3 of the Call for Participation.

The activities will be carried out entirely in English and in blended mode with the following schedule:

- Host-Fungus Interactions and Virulence: One health Approach: in-presence activities from 19 May to 23 May (Braga, Portugal) and online activities from 26 May to 30 May;
- Mechanism and Regulation of Cell Death and Autophagy: online activities from 7 April to 11
 April and 28 April to 2 May and in-presence activities from 5 May to 9 May (Braga, Portugal).

Selected students are guaranteed a financial contribution to cover travel and accommodation costs for the period of the in-presence activities.

2. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Students who are regularly enrolled for the academic year 2024/2025 in the second year of the degree course in Food Health and Environment of the Department of Sustainable Development and Ecological Transition may apply.

The maximum number of months of Erasmus+ international mobility for female students is 12 months per degree programme; it is the student's responsibility to ensure that the maximum allowed threshold is not exceeded.

Students who have already carried out, are carrying out or will carry out a period of international mobility using an Erasmus+ Mobility Grant for Study or Traineeship in the academic year 2024/2025 may participate in this selection, provided that the periods of physical mobility do not coincide.

3. RECOGNITION OF THE ACTIVITY

Activities carried out within BIP projects will be recognised as follows:



- Host-Fungus Interactions and Virulence: One health Approach: 6 extra-curricular CFU to be recognised as TAF D activity;
- Mechanism and Regulation of Cell Death and Autophagy: 5 extra-curricular CFU to be recognised as TAF D activity.

The ECTS (University Credits) to which the two BIP projects correspond will be recognised as international mobility activities, to which an additional two extra-curricular ECTS (University Credits) will be assigned in relation to the increased commitment. Please also note that the activity carried out in international mobility allows the recognition of additional marks to be attributed to the final degree grade.

4. APPLICATION SUBMISSION

Applications must be submitted exclusively online via the <u>Google Form</u> by noon on 31/03/2025.

Applications submitted after this deadline will not be considered.

5. APPLICATION SELECTION CRITERIA AND RANKING LIST

After assessing the eligibility of applications, a ranking of the shortlisted candidates will be drawn up based on the following criteria

- weighted average of marks as at 31/03/2025;
- number of ECTS (University Credits) acquired as at 31/03/2025.

The ranking list, issued following approval of the acts by the Director of the Department of Sustainable Development and Ecological Transition, will be published on the University notice board and on the Department's web page, at the following link: https://disste.uniupo.it/it/bacheca/bandi.

If a winner does not wish to make the mobility move, the ranking list will be moved.

6. FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTIONS

As defined in the European Commission's Erasmus+ Programme Guide, students on short-term physical mobility receive a contribution of €79,00 per day and up to 2 days of travel funded with a contribution of €275,00.

7. INSURANCE COVER

During the entire residential period and during their teaching activities, the selected students are guaranteed civil liability and <u>insurance</u> cover provided for students at the University.



8. ENTRY INTO THE HOST COUNTRY

Non-EU/EU students must prove that they hold a valid residence permit in Italy for the entire period of their stay abroad to be able to sign the contract for the financial contribution and benefit from it.

9. REFUNCTION

Any cancellations must be notified promptly by e-mail to domanda.erasmus@uniupo.it.

10. PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA, TRANSPARENCY, CONTROLLER

The data transmitted by the candidate(s) will be processed only for the purposes related to the management of the procedure, in compliance with the Laws on the protection of personal data (EU Regulation 2016/679 - 'GDPR' - Legislative Decree 196/2003, as amended by Legislative Decree 101/2018 - Code on the protection of personal data - and all relevant provisions of the Italian Data Protection Authority and the European Committee for the Protection of Personal Data.
